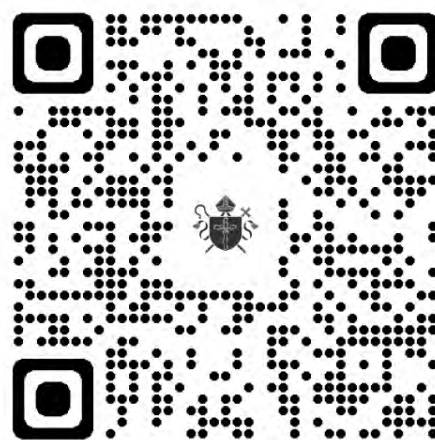
Share your opinions with us!
