**School admissions to Catholic Primary Academies**

(Reception Year) Children born between 01/09/2019 and 31/08/2020

The deadline for submitting your application for a school place is 15<sup>th</sup> January 2024. Application forms are available on your 'home' Local Authority website.

For every Catholic school you apply for if you wish your child to be considered and ranked under a faith criterion, you should also complete a supplementary information form and return this form to the school by the deadline (forms are available from the LA and the school).

You MUST also include the supporting evidence\* as required with this form e.g. baptism certificate (photocopies are acceptable). Failure to supply the required supporting evidence will mean your child is ranked in a lower criterion which may affect your chance of a place.

\*If you do not have the required evidence please contact the parish where your child was baptised for a copy certificate in good time.
